

DMT Administrative Upgrade Study

Objective/Task Description What is the purpose and scope of work for the task?

A study is needed to determine if the existing site of our administrative offices and garage at 101 N. Jackson Street can be modified to provide for our needs without purchasing additional land. This study would consider the essential components that would allow accessibility and functionality, as well as additional storage for our buses and equipment.

Schedule What is the anticipated time schedule, including start and end dates?

Anticipated to be approximately 12 weeks, beginning spring 2019.

Benefit How does this task help to implement the Long Range Transportation Plan?

One purpose of the LRTP is to increase accessibility and complement the integration of multimodal systems. With CRIS Rural MTD using our new terminal facility, and now the introduction of a Greyhound Connect service as well, foot traffic at our administrative offices has increased the need for enhanced, accessible customer interface. DMT provides identification cards and ticket sales for not only our own customers, but CRIS and now Greyhound customers at our Jackson Street offices. Our building is over 30 years old and is almost completely inaccessible. The Jackson Street building was constructed with the intention of housing eight (8) buses and nineteen (19) employees. Our fleet has now grown to sixteen (16) and our personnel now numbers thirty (30).
