- a. Voorhees St. Bridge over Lick Creek (SN 092-0153) & Voorhees St. Bridge over East Fork of Lick Creek (SN 092-0155)

Cole discussed the project locations, costs, and staging and City's desire to improve bridges prior to have to complete load rating reductions. City has received Special Bridge funding for FY25 for SN 092-0153 and has reapplied for funding for SN 092-0155. If awarded funding in this grant cycle, SN 092-0155 would be funded in FY26.

VII. **Old Business**

a. **Agency Reports**

- 1. City of Danville- Denmark Road started back up.
- 2. Vermilion County- CH14 improvements are on IDOT's April 29 letting. Pilot township bridge project is starting.
- 3. Towns/Villages (Tilton, Georgetown, Westville, Catlin, Belgium) – No Report
- 4. IDOT – I-74 over Salt Fork River was expected to start back up on March 28th, work is resuming for striping and seeding for Tilton Rd. over I-74, and signal improvement to Ross Lane/Rte. 1 are currently waiting on materials.
- 5. FHWA/FTA – No Report
- 6. DMT – Have hired some new drivers and hope to be adding routes back soon. Facility project is currently on hold while IDOT evaluated impact of census on Urban/Rural status.
- 7. CRIS – Facility project is currently on hold while IDOT evaluated impact of census on DMT & CRIS. Recently increase starting wages from \$14/hr to \$16/hr.

9. Other Items – Discussed federal project opportunities and potential impacts of HB4489 on local agency GATA reporting requirements.
