#### 1. TIP Amendment

1. Safety Action Plan & SS4A application - Cole discussed that the Vermilion County Safety Action Plan (VCSAP) was completed and the final application for the joint City of Danville/Vermilion County SS4A grant was submitted.

2. Upcoming Planning Efforts – Cole discussed that FY24 planning efforts tentatively include Kickapoo Rail Trail (KRT) route alternatives study, pavement condition data updates for Vermilion County and the City of Danville, Catlin Township study of Webster St., and DMT/CRIS route planning studies. Depending on other grant funds received, some of these efforts may change. Currently, they cannot all be funded, so this is a priority list.

##### 1. City of Danville

Cole updated the committee on the status of the Denmark Rd. project closeout. He indicated that bids came in well over estimate for E. Williams St. (Bowman to State) and the project will be bid out again in November.
