

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-46

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF STATEWIDE PLANNING AND  
RESEARCH FUNDS FROM THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION FOR THE CITY OF DANVILLE FREIGHT STUDY**

WHEREAS, the City of Danville is a home rule unit of local government with authority to legislate in matters concerning its local government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2018, IDOT issued a "Call for Project" for Statewide Planning and Research (SPR) Funds; and

WHEREAS, the SPR funds are available for transportation planning including multi-modal, highways, active transportation, rail (passenger and freight) and transit; and

WHEREAS, SPR funds cannot be used on preliminary engineering, design, right-of-way, construction or maintenance projects;

WHEREAS, the City of Danville does not have an existing freight study and vision;

WHEREAS, the study will identify existing freight bottlenecks, barriers to additional freight growth, and opportunities to increase freight related development, growth, and jobs, in the City of Danville and surrounding area;

WHEREAS, the Freight Study is estimated to cost \$100,000 of which a \$20,000 City of Danville local match is required; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authority of the City of Danville desire to pass this Resolution to demonstrate its support for the application of the Statewide Planning and Research Funds and the City of Danville Freight Study.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY  
COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF DANVILLE, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION ONE:** That staff is authorized to proceed with the Statewide Planning and Research Funds application for the City of Danville Freight Study. The City Council further states its support of the City of Danville Freight Study as well as its support and acknowledgement of the local matching requirements of same.

**SECTION TWO:** That the City Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the Mayor on said Agreement and retain an original in her office for public inspection.

**SECTION THREE:** That the local matching requirements will be paid for from the Motor Fuel Tax Fund, Fund 103.
